If you have people you want to sit with, please make sure you buy their tickets at the same time. We will not be able to change seating arrangements once bookings are made.

General Admission events do not offer a seating plan and do not have any allocated seating.

The Art Deco Trust Ticket Exchange can be accessed from the Art Deco Trust website at www.artdeconapier.com under Events.

We strongly recommend that you do not buy (or sell) any tickets that are delivered via email and are printed on standard paper on the Art Deco Ticket Exchange.

This style of ticket can be easily mass printed by those wishing to deceive. Tickets printed on standard ticket stock will be a more secure item to trade on the ticket exchange.

Make sure you have read and understand the rules published on the Ticket Exchange before you enter into any transactions.

GETTING HERE AND AROUND THE FESTIVAL

FLYING Hawke's Bay Airport is a fantastic airport very close to Napier City.

ADDITIONAL BUS SERVICES HASTINGS - NAPIER - HASTINGS

Running from Hastings, through Taradale, along Kennedy Road and into the Napier CBD, these additional Route 12 services are designed to help you to get to the Festival at key times and make sure you can get home late into the evening. MARINE PARADE DECO SHUTTLE Brought to you by Napier City Council. AHURIRI-CBD DECO SHUTTLE Brought to you by Napier City Council. Operating every half hour this shuttle will depart from the bus stop outside the Bluewater Hotel, then stop at Spriggs Park beside The Boardwalk and finish at Browning Street outside Conservation House. These same stops will be used for the return journey during the following times: Fri 21 Feb, 5pm - 10pm. Sat 22 Feb, 10am - 10pm. Sun 23 Feb, 10am - 5pm. Cost: Gold coin donation per passenger (one way)

ALMOST EVERYTHING IS IN WALKING DISTANCE

The majority of events happen within the Napier CBD which is an extremely user friendly walkable city.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation in Hawke's Bay during the Festival is always at a premium and we do urge you to book early, however there are several ways to accommodate your stay:

NAPIER i-SITE

Art Deco Trust have partnered with Napier i-SITE to manage accommodation enquires. Napier i-SITE are in regular contact with the majority of accommodation providers, Hotels, Motels, B & B's and Holiday Houses in Hawke's Bay and surrounding areas. They will also monitor cancellations and offer to visitors who have contacted them. As the largest event in Hawke's Bay, accommodation is limited and does get booked up early, however, despite assumption, it is not fully booked! FESTIVAL FREE PARKING Take the hassle out of finding parking and use the Festival free parking located north and south of the 'Spirit of Napier', Marine Parade. Catch a gold coin shuttle in, or take the beautiful 900m stroll along the Napier water front. Parking operates from Fri 21 Feb to Sun 23 Feb.

VINTAGE CAR PARKING Vintage cars registered in Saturday's Vintage Car Parade are permitted entry and parking in the restricted area subject to certain conditions and availability. Limited parking on the lower lawn between the path and sea is available for Vintage Cars not participating in the Vintage Car Parade. Entry is ticketed and by permit only. For more information and bookings, contact the Art Deco Trust – festival@artdeconapier.com.

[NOTE: Vintage cars parked in this area on Sunday 23 February will have limited access and movement due to the Gatsby Picnic.]

ACCESSIBILITY

MOBILITY PARKING Mobility parking and entry to the inner city is restricted during the Art Deco Festival. Mobility access at some events is also limited. Please contact the Art Deco Trust for parking permits, street access, drop off points and for general venue accessibility information: festival@artdeconapier.com

WHEELCHAIR ACCESS Please advise of any special seating requirements including wheelchair and/or companion seating when booking.

WATER, FOOD AND SUN PROTECTION

It's vital to stay well hydrated, fed and protected under the Hawke's Bay summer sun. Water fountains can be located by the Sound Shell to fill up water bottles. St Johns are onsite throughout the Festival and are located at the Sound Shell for any medical assistance. Please remember to bring hats and wear sunscreen.

ALCOHOL

The Napier Art Deco Festival is a family friendly event. There are many bars and restaurants in central Napier for you to enjoy their hospitality or we have an Art Deco Hospitality Tent on the Lower Lawn in front of the Sound Shell. Please refrain from bringing your own alcohol into the city during the festival. For up to date information please go to www.artdeconapier.com closer to the event.

ABOUT HAWKE'S BAY

FOOD Hawke's Bay is widely regarded as the 'food bowl' of New Zealand and there are numerous ways you can nibble and sup on the best of Hawke's Bay. One of the best places to start is at the Hawke's Bay Farmers' Market which brings together many of the region's artisan sellers every Sunday. The dining scene is nationally regarded with the long-established winery restaurants now strongly complemented by a burgeoning array of award-winning urban restaurants.

WINE Hawke's Bay has been producing wine for over 150 years, making it New Zealand's oldest wine region. More than 80% of the country's plantings of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah grapes are grown here, earning the region an established reputation for producing high quality red wines along with rich complex Chardonnays. Be sure to taste a drop or two at one of the 30+ cellar doors dotted around the region.

HAWKE'S BAY TRAILS

With 200km of flat, easy riding cycle trails, the Hawke's Bay Trails network is an easy and safe way to explore the region. Take in the sights at a leisurely pace and stop along the way at one of many cafes, restaurants and wineries. The trails spread over the patchwork of orchards, vineyards and gardens criss-crossing the Heretaunga Plains. Discover panoramic views of the coastal landscape including the spectacular Cape Kidnappers, the iconic Te Mata Peak, the distant Kaweka and Ruahine ranges, tucked away in our version of a Mediterranean oasis. HASTINGS

There is plenty to explore in Hastings including: Nga Pou o Heretaunga – 19 pou, each representing an ancestor from marae around the Heretaunga district. Hastings Icons – large-scale screenprints on public walls throughout the city. Hastings City Art Gallery – free entry to local, national and international contemporary art exhibitions. Art Inc Heretaunga – the Hastings Community Arts Centre Gallery showcasing Hawke's Bay artists and crafts people.

1931 HAWKE'S BAY EARTHQUAKE COMMEMORATIVE LECTURE

The Hawke's Bay Branch of the Royal Society Te Apārangi, presents The 1931 Hawke's Bay Earthquake Commemorative Lecture ... 'Unlocking the Secrets of the Hikurangi Subduction Zone'. Have you ever wondered about that sleeping giant that lies beneath Hawke's Bay, known as the Hikurangi subduction zone?

Dr. Laura Wallace is a geophysicist from GNS Science who has spent her career studying the Hikurangi subduction zone. She will discuss the results of scientific studies that reveal what the subduction zone is currently up to. 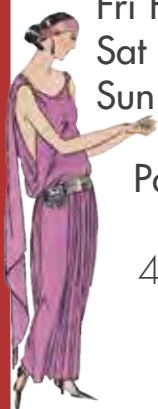
